
### Personalities, Talent, Honorary Awards



#### MAMORU HOSODA Grand Honorary Award

He launched his career at Toei Animation, where he learned his trade as an animator. Between 2005 and 2011, he became one of the leading innovators of animated films thanks to his work at the Madhouse Studio, a period during which he released groundbreaking and visionary works including The Girl Who Leapt Through Time (2006) and Summer Wars (2009). In 2011 he created his own company, Studio Chizu, and shaped his most daring and personal works, Wolf Children (2012), The Boy and the Beast (2015), Mirai (2018) and the recent Belle:The Dragon and the Freckled Princess (2021).

#### PERSONALITIES, TALENT, HONORARY AWARDS



#### **BELÉN RUEDA** Grand Honorary Award

After a highly successful first stage in her career connected to television, she became one of the most celebrated scream queens in Spanish fantastic films thanks to The Orphanage (2007), a performance that garnered her a nomination for Best Actress at the Goya Awards, a category she would end up winning at the Fantasporto festival. Years later, she would return in even more well-loved genre movies including the neo-noir Julia's Eyes (2010), twisted thrillers such as The Body (2012) and Perfect Strangers (2017), and even sci-fi in Órbita 9 (2017).

#### **CARLOS SAURA** Grand Honorary Award

Director, screenwriter and photographer, active since 1956, he made a name for himself internationally with The Hunt (1966), a devastating and courageous allegory of Francoist Spain that won the Award for Best Director at the Berlin Film Festival. Afterwards came indisputable classics in Spanish moviemaking including Anna and the Wolves (1973), Cría Cuervos (1976), Mama Turns 100 (1979) and Deprisa, Deprisa (1981), films with an irresistible, uncompromising and free-thinking personality. His collaborations with Vitorio Storaro, Tango (1998) or Goya in Bordeaux (1999), are full of fantastique-inspired images.



#### PERSONALITIES, TALENT, HONORARY AWARDS



ALICE KRINGE Time Machine Award

In 1981, the same year of her feature debut in Chariots of Fire, she became a familiar face in fantastic and horror movies when she co-starred in Ghost Story, one of the greatest ghost stories of the eighties. In subsequent years, after joining the prestigious Royal Shakespeare Company, she returned to genre with Sleepwalkers (1992), played the Borg Queen in Star Trek: First Contact (1996) and excelled as the witch Holda in Gretel & Hansel (2020). She will be starring in the upcoming reboot of The Texas Chainsaw Massacre.





With a background in the field of 3D animation, visual effects and advertising, he made his big leap to film with District 9 (2009), a science fiction feature set in his native Johannesburg that garnered four Academy Award nominations, including Best Picture and Best Adapted Screenplay. After continuing in genre with the dystopias Elysium (2013) and Chappie (2015), in 2017 he created Oats Studios, an independent production company specializing in experimental fantastic and horror short films.



NICK ANTOSCA Time Machine Award

He began his career as a horror novel writer, and after winning the Shirley Jackson Award in 2009 for Midnight Picnic, he became a screenwriter for television series such as Teen Wolf and Hannibal. In 2016, he made the big leap as a showrunner of Channel Zero, a four-season miniseries where he redefined the visual imaginary of modern horror starting from famous creepypastas. In 2021, he debuted on Netflix with Brand New Cherry Flavor, one of the year's major TV sensations, and in Sitges he is presenting a film produced by Guillermo del Toro, Antlers.

#### LUCILE HADZIHALILOVIC Career Méliès 2021


EMILIO GUTIÉRREZ CAVA Nosferatu Award

After graduating from the Institut Des Hautes Études Cinématographiques in Paris, she embarked on her career as a director, writer, editor and actress in both feature and short films. In 2004, she made her feature debut with Innocence, a San Sebastian award-winner and one of the most suggestive fantastique films of its time. Her second endeavor, Evolution (2015), was in charge of closing the Noves Visions section in Sitges, a film that confirmed her as one of the most fascinating and personal voices in European fantastic genre.

Born in Valladolid into a family of actors, he scored his first hit in 1963 starring in a theatrical adaptation of Peter Pan. His first foray into horror is legendary: the beyond the grave romance with Dyanik Zurakowska in The Sweet Sound of Death (1965). Between 1966 and 1967 he appeared in three iconic Historias para no dormir by Chicho Ibáñez Serrador: El cuervo, La sonrisa and La espera. Subsequently, his love affair with genre continued in cult films such as Estigma (1980), Viaje al más allá (1980) and Memorias del ángel caído (1997). In 2001 he received the Goya Award for Best Supporting Actor in Common Wealth. He is still active after more than six decades in the profession.

ROQUE BAÑOS Maria Honorífica

A Summa Cum Laude graduate of Boston's Berklee College of Music with majors in film scoring and jazz performance, he is one of the most awarded and respected film score composers of his generation. He has been active since 1997, has won three Coyas and has a special affinity for the fantastic and horror genres. He is the go-to musician for genre figures such as Álex de la Iglesia and Fede Álvarez. He has also worked with Jaume Balagueró, Alejandro Amenábar, Terry Gilliam and Spike Lee.



#### **1.** Auditori



With a seating capacity for 1,384 spectators, it is one of the largest in South Europe. It is fitted out with modern film screening technologies, including a new generation screen. The opening and closing ceremonies are held here and from five to seven daily Official Selection screenings and special gala ceremonies during the Festival. It is equipped with 35 and 70 mm all DCP formats projectors for 1,33-1,66-1,85-Scope formats. In addition, as well as with Dolby Stereo, Dolby SRD, DTS and Dolby SDDS sound

#### **2.** El Retiro Cinema



This iconic Festival venue was its headquarters for many years and is located in the center of town. It was completely renovated just recently. With a seating capacity for 600 spectators, it holds from three to five daily screenings during the Festival from sections like Panorama, Midnight Xtreme and tributes. It is equipped with a new 35 mm all DCP formats projector for 1,33-1,66-1,85-Scope formats and with Dolby Stereo sound.

#### **3.** Casino Prado



Another historical site venue that houses different Festival sections, like Noves Visions, Anima't, Seven Chances and special marathons. It has a seating capacity of 450 and a 35 mm all DCP formats projector for 1,33-1,66-1,85-Scope formats and is equipped with Dolby Stereo sound.



#### **4.** Tramuntana Room

A cinema venue within the Hotel Melia facilities, equipped with film material, a 640 x 343 screen and a capacity for 400 people. It houses press screenings as well as Official Selection screenings, master classes and events like Sitges Coming Soon.

#### **6.** Fantastic Kids

This room offers a selection of fantastic artistic that have already captivated audiences around the world. Admission to this venue is free, and there will be a varied lineup of shorts throughout the day.

#### **5.** Brigadoon Section

The Noucentista building that was the old Sitges abattoir, built in 1920 by Josep Maria Martino, is a multipurpose cultural space since it was renovated in 1991. It houses and exhibits some of the elements from Sitges' festive heritage and, during the Festival, becomes the Brigadoon movie theater, presenting an intense ten day lineup with this section's characteristic hallmark. During the Festival it also offers bar service.


#### 7. King Kong Area

The area where the Festival's main leisure venues are located: all the activities that take place in Meeting and the Mercat Vell, the Foodtastic's gastronomy and the Fanshop's merchandising.

#### Engagement and community. New technologies and fandom.

Film Hub also hosts several acts in collaboration with the country's leading audiovisual entities. Amongst others, we will have in this edition the PROA (Federated Audiovisual Producers) entity that organises a day with producer working groups with sales agents. The Catalonia Film Commission offers the presentation of the Guide for incorporating sustainability criteria into filming and filming. Also, there will be Producers Meet Producers, the annual meeting between consolidated producers and novel producers, organised by PAC and the City Council of Sitges.

#### *Méliès d'Or Awards*

For the fourth consecutive year, the Sitges – International Fantastic Film Festival of Catalonia organizes the award ceremony of the Méliès d'Or.

The Méliès d'Or and Méliès d'Argent prizes are awarded each year to the best European feature and short fantastic films. These awards are a recognition of their quality and creativity levels and generate unique visibility for films and their directors. The awards are awarded by the Méliès International Festivals Federation (MIFF)

#### Sitges Cocoon

Sitges Cocoon is a programme made in the Sitges - International Fantastic Film Festival of Catalonia that unites technology and fantastic and genre cinema. This program is divided into four sections: Other Realities dedicated to new technological tools applied to film production, Cocoon Presents for presentations of finished audiovisual projects that relate technology, genre and fantastic, NFT Creations which presents projects f rom creation to production and distribution management with NFT, and, finally, the Videogame and Cinema section dedicated to technology, video games and fantastic and genre cinema. This event has the scientif ic curatorship of Jordi Sánchez-Navarro (Universitat Oberta de Catalunya).

# Woman In Fan

"A girl walks alone... The figure of the female filmmaker within the fantastic is considered a rare bird. The cultural and social patterns that prevail in the film industry have traditionally identified certain genres as belonging to female sensibilities, entrusting the leadership of projects within terror, science fiction, action or thriller, for example, to male creators."



#### WOMAN IN FAN: Women Who Scare

WOMAN IN FAN was the flagship program at Sitges 2021. This project, aimed at increasing the visibility of female creators in fantastic genre, and that has the mission to highlight the work of women filmmakers who are creators in fantastic genre, also included different activities related to the talks and encounters with the creators themselves. And one of them was the traveling exhibition Woman in Fan: Women Who Scare *(See photo below).*  Thanks to the support of Vertix, Dama Autor and Acció Cine, Sitges' libraries have been able to enjoy this journey through the careers of 14 of the most iconic women in the world of fantastic films who have visited Sitges. Names ranging from Cameron Diaz or Susan Sarandon to Carolina Munro and Tilda Swinton are part of this exhibition. A fine sampling of the importance of women in genre.



#### THE RETURN OF WALDEMAR DANINSKY

Curated by DIEGO LÓPEZ-FERNÁNDEZ, Brigadoon Section Programmer and Festival Direction Assistant.

The exhibition The Return of Waldemar Daninsky illustrates the work of actor and director Jacinto Molina in the role of the wolfman Waldemar Daninsky. From his birth in 1968, thanks to Enrique López Eguiluz's film Frankenstein's Bloody Terror, to his final howl in 2006 with Ivan Cardoso's A Werewolf in the Amazon, five decades are unveiled through posters, scripts, books, comics, press books and original pieces used in the 15+1 films where Jacinto Molina transformed into the legendary wolf man.

The image of the lycanthrope inspires an edition of the Sitges Festival that invites to be savored under the influence of the full moon. At midnight, the fans of this film event dedicated to the most extraordinary fantaterror on Earth lets their beast within flow. Sixteen names from the world of comics and illustration conscientiously depicted the exploits of the most dangerous and uncontrollable nocturnal creature imaginable, offering a feast of fantastical. The exhibition brings together the unpublished art of Albert Monteys, Mermelada de sesos, Magius, Sara Bea, Ángel, Olga de Castro, Fermín Solís, Cels Piñol, Álex Orbe, Laura Pérez, Ata, Ladrón, Roberto González, Pedro Vera, Paco Cavero, and David León.



#### **THE BEAST WITHIN** Hydes, Lycanthropes And Other Therianthropic Figures In The Audiovisual Imaginary

This book is an invitation to explore the different aspects of the cinematic treatment of the beast that resides within human beings. Werewolves, Hyde lords, cat women and other human-beast crossbreeds parade through its pages in a journey that spans from the foundational texts of Greco-Latin culture to contemporary film and from classical Hollywood to Eastern European auteur cinema. The topics and places visited in this book offer readers a chance to take a head-on look at these inner beasts, which are nothing more than incarnations of what frightens us about ourselves.

Coordinated by Ángel Sala and Jordi Sánchez-Navarro, *The Beast Within* features contributions by the coordinators themselves and by Lluís Rueda, Violeta Kovacsics, Marta Torres, Diego López and Mike Hostench. In these authors' writings, readers will find texts of various kinds, in a polyphony of formats and styles that provide new perspectives and new ideas regarding a fantastic film legend that continues to enjoy enormous vitality.
